




XiteBio® Trial Results


The latest field trial data is in and as expected, XiteBio[®] Yield+ & XiteBio[®] Tuber+ continue to deliver superior performance. Wheat crops treated with XiteBio[®] Yield+ are demonstrating an average yield increase of 2.8 bushels per acre compared to the untreated check. These results have been consistently observed across multiple trials, including those conducted with Double Diamond Farm and New Era Ag Technologies, both based in Manitoba. While the potatoes trial with SynAgri in Quebec saw XiteBio[®] Tuber+ treated sections has a 19 bag/acre increase.
